Mr. Timothy F. Brick served 14 years on the Pasadena Utility Advisory Commission, which directs the municipal water and power department, including four terms as chair. He is a member of the Colorado River Water Users Associations, National Water Resources Association and a member of the board of POWER (Public Officials for Water & Environmental Reform). He also belongs to the Audubon Society, the Nature Conservancy and the Society for Ecological Restoration.

Brick was vice-chair of the MWD board from 1998-2000 and chaired the Water Planning & Resources Committee (1995-1998) as well as the Headquarters Committee, which developed MWD's Union Station Headquarters. The following committees have been chaired by Mr. Brick: the Water Education, Water Quality and the Strategic Plan Implementation.
